## DATA CALL SUBMISSION DATES

***When is the Data Call Due this year?*** See [recent cable](#). While your data call is due no later than the due date listed for your region, go ahead and submit early if you can. Just make sure that you received the mid-July reference table update beforehand.

### WORKLOAD BUDGET SUBMISSION DUE DATES:



## TARGET "ERROR" MESSAGES

Ignore target "error" message when running *Verify* on your data call plan, as explained in [last year's newsletter](#).

## BASELINE ???

***Avoid unnecessary rejections*** — Don't baseline your budget before you submit the data call (see [last year's newsletter](#) dated July 2008).



## DATA CALL SUBMISSION STATUS

### ***Before you go away on that much deserved vacation...***

...confirm that we received your data call (see [previous newsletter](#)). Otherwise, we'll be calling your colleagues or even supervisors for assistance (IVG's toll free, and we know your number!).



## DATA CALL STATUS: "NOT SUBMITTED"

***Hey... don't forget as we explained in [last year's newsletter](#) -***

To help distinguish between the data call submission and the submission of your initial and final budgets, we added a new field "Data Call Status" to separately track the status of your submitted data call. For more information on how "Data Call Status" works, see page 44 of the user manual.
